



前言:

相信同學們對於 The Hunger Games (中文譯本《飢餓遊戲》)和 Divergent (中文譯本《分歧者》)都不陌生,小說中兩位女主角堅韌勇敢的形象更是令人印象深刻。而如果你喜歡這兩本小說,那 The Giver 絕對是你下一本該拜讀的作品!原因一:記憶傳承人正是 The Hunger Games、Divergent 以及許多著名反烏托邦文學的始祖;原因二:在 The Giver 中,你將看到比前述兩部作品中,更貼近現實卻也更令人震撼的未來世界。

我有幸在2014年看了The Giver 的電影,之後才買了小說,細細探索Lois Lowry二十多年前構築的理想國,對於先看電影再看書深感懊悔。對我來說,觀影永遠無法戰勝閱讀,而這樣的感受在閱讀The Giver 時更加深刻,畢竟,電影某種程度剝奪了讀者自由想像的權利。

因此,我在此誠摯邀請每位讀者,翻開這本雖經歷時代變遷,卻越顯耀眼的讀物,造訪 我有幸見識的,Lois Lowry 筆下,那理想的世界。
